MRF Carp Rules

1.) All boats and fisherman must comply with all federal/state/local laws and regulations at all times. Including (but not limited to):

- a.) All boats must have valid MT registration (as required by law)
- b.) All fisherman must have a valid MT fishing/conservation license
- c.) Floatation devices must be on-board and accessible for each person
- d.) No trespassing on private property (stay within traditional high-water mark or on public land)

2.) Only traditional fly-fishing gear & methods may be used to angle for the carp

- a.) Single hooked, artificial fly-styled lures only
 - 1.) No live bait
 - 2.) No Treble Hooks
 - 3.) No chicken livers, rotten meat, etc.
 - 4.) No intentional snagging or spearing allowed

3.) All watercraft, trailers, live wells and fishing equipment must be presented for inspection at check-in to ensure they have been properly cleaned of aquatic weeds and animals. Any unclean equipment will have to be taken to a power car wash and cleaned prior to entry.

*** We ask that all boats/equipment be washed after the tournament as well, to ensure no cross contamination occurs to the next river you fish!!!

4.) All other fish species must be released after being caught (please keep records of every species you catch so we can complete our biologist's report).

5.) Angling must be confined to the waters of the Missouri River located between Pelican Point FAS and the Ulm Bridge

6.) All competing fishermen must be present for the rules meeting at 8:45 am.

*Registration will begin at 8:15 am at the Lions Club Park Complex North of Cascade at the intersection of 1st Street North and the Ulm-Cascade Frontage Rd.

7.) Other river users will be given right-of-way during contest hours.
